

Teklas USA Inc. Website Privacy Policy

1. Introduction

Teklas USA Inc. (“**Teklas**”) is committed to protecting the personal information we may collect. This privacy policy (this “**Policy**”) describes our policies and practices regarding collection, use, and disclosure of personal information. This privacy policy applies only to information collected through our website www.teklas.com (the “**Website**”) and applies specifically to consumers located in the United States.

2. Changes to this Privacy Policy

Teklas may revise this Policy from time to time. When we make changes to this Policy, we will post the updated version on our Website and indicate the date the Policy was last updated. We encourage you to review this Policy periodically to check for any updates. Your continued use of our Website indicates your consent to the terms of this Policy.

3. Children’s Privacy

This Website is not intended for children under 13 years of age and we do not knowingly collect personal information relating to children. If we learn we have collected or received personal information from a child under 13 without verification of parental consent, we will delete that information.

4. Information Collected

Personal information we collect through our Website includes:

- First and last name
- Email address
- Any other personal information you choose to provide as a comment on a blog post or news story on our Website. Please be aware that any such comments may be displayed publicly on our Website along with your name.

Please note that we also provide an email address on our Website through which you can submit an employment application.

We may also collect usage and device information as you use our Website. For example, during your visit to our Website, we may capture your browser type, device information, and IP address in order to monitor the way you interact with the Website and compile aggregated statistics. Our Website also uses cookies (see the Cookies & Tracking Technologies section below for further information).

5. Cookies & Tracking Technologies

We may use cookies and similar tracking technologies to track activity on our Website. Cookies are files with a small amount of data which may include a unique identifier. Cookies are sent to your browser from a website and stored on your device. We may also use other tracking technologies such as beacons, tags and scripts to collect and track information and to improve and analyze our Website.

Our Website uses third parties to assist us in analyzing data regarding visitors to our Website. For example, we use Google Analytics to collect information about the number of visitors to a site, the webpage that referred visitors to a site, and the pages visitors view within a site. You can opt-out of Google Analytics by downloading [Google's Opt-Out Browser Add-on](#).

Third parties may set and access cookies on your device and may collect information about your online activities across different websites, including our Website. Additionally, some internet browsers have "Do Not Track" or "DNT" features which, when turned on, send a signal to the website that the individual visiting the website does not wish to be tracked. Our Website does not currently respond to DNT signals, but you may adjust your cookie settings in your browser.

6. Information Use

We use the personal information we collect through our Website to provide our products and services.

Additionally, Teklas may use the information we collect about you, including personal information, for the following purposes:

- To communicate with you and respond to your inquiries;
- To provide information you have requested;
- To provide information or advertisements that may be of interest to you;
- To administer and improve our Website;
- To develop new features and services;
- To generate statistics and de-identified data;
- To prevent, detect or fight fraud or illegal activities;
- To comply with legal requirements; and
- For any other purpose with your consent.

7. Information Disclosure

We may disclose the information we collect about you, including personal information, to our service providers to help us operate and improve our services and Website. For example, we disclose information to third party data analytics providers who help us understand and track the use of our Website.

We also may disclose information as required by law or law enforcement; or in the event of a corporate transaction such as a merger, sale, or acquisition.

Teklas does not sell personal information.

8. Data Security

We take appropriate physical, technical, and organizational security measures designed to protect your personal information. Please note, however, transmission of information via the internet is not completely secure and any transmission of personal information is at your own risk.

9. Third Party Links

For practical reasons or for your information, our Website might contain links to other websites, such as our pages on various social media sites. Teklas exercises no control over such other websites and is not responsible for the content thereon.
